These are some questions that new pupils ask. Can you help them with their concerns, by matching the questions to the right answers.



Many of you will travel to Llanfyllin on the school bus. The bus companies know that new Year 7 pupils will be on their buses **so don't worry!!** If you know someone travelling on your school bus it would be a good idea to ask them to look after you on the bus. The bus will drop you inside the school grounds.

If you travel by car to school please ask your parents to drop you near to, but not immediately in front of, the school doors as it will be very busy at that time in the morning. A speed limit of 5 mph will be exercised.

If you are walking to school make your way safely along the pavement and remember your green cross code when crossing any roads.

Once inside the school gates you must not leave school without Mr Rudge's permission.

At the end of the day there will be staff on hand to help you catch the correct bus home.
