The Ysgol Llanfyllin uniform consists of:

- ✓ A Plain Navy Blue V Neck Jumper with Logo
- ✓ Black Trousers, Tailored Shorts or Skirt
- ✓ White Polo Shirt (Foundation Phase to Year 6)
- ✓ White Shirt and the School Tie (Year 7 – 11)

All required items are available from the approved suppliers listed below or suitable high street alternatives can be purchased with a sew on or iron on logo purchased from the school.

Uniform Specifics

- ✓ **Jumper**- A plain V neck navy blue school jumper or high street V neck navy-blue jumper with a sew on or iron on badge (available from Ysgol Llanfyllin at a cost of £1). Hoodies or non-school jumpers will not be permitted.
- ✓ **Shirts / blouses** - Plain white, or white short-sleeved. Shirts/blouses should be clearly tucked into trousers/skirts. Plain white t-shirts may be worn under the shirt.
- ✓ **Trousers** - All trousers must be black and be a smart school style only (no denim material).
- ✓ **Tailored Shorts**- All tailored shorts must be black and be a smart school style, no sport shorts.
- ✓ **Skirts**- Skirts must be black and of an appropriate length (no more than 2 inches above the knee). Skirts must be worn as intended, not altered or rolled up at the waist to make them shorter and we recommend that they are not of stretchy material
- ✓ **Socks** - Grey, navy, black or white (ankle or three-quarter length). No trainer socks. Pupils may wear natural, plain grey or black tights.
- ✓ **Headwear** - With the exception of any religious dress code requirements, no form of headwear is permitted in the school building.
- ✓ **Outdoor coats** – any suitable style will be permitted
- ✓ **Jewellery** - No jewellery, except one small sleeper or stud per ear and a watch
- ✓ **Make Up** – Foundation/Concealer should be discreet, neutral in colour and natural in appearance. False nails, nail extensions, nail varnish, mascara and false eyelashes are NOT permitted.
- ✓ **Hair** - Should not be dyed with any unnatural colours. Tramlines or patterns cut into the hair are not permitted. Any hair accessories should be small and plain.
- ✓ **Footwear** - Pupils should wear sensible plain black footwear to school. The Headteacher reserves the right to ask students to change their footwear should they judge them unsuitable for school. Boots are acceptable during inclement weather, and should be worn under trousers and shoes with significant heels will not be allowed, as they are dangerous. We discourage flat 'pump' shoes.
