Families living outside Powys will need to advise the Schools Admission Teams at both Powys County Council and Shropshire County Council should they wish their child to transfer from Primary School to Ysgol Llanfyllin for Year 7.

Our Progress Manager with responsibility for years 5,6&7 will visit all partner primary schools during the Summer Term to meet pupils who will be joining us in the following September, and an opportunity for new pupils and parents to visit the school is arranged towards the end of that term. An Open Evening is held in October for prospective parents. Details and dates are published on our website and parents informed via primary schools. The admissions limit (the maximum number of pupils we can accept into any year group) is currently 157. The Headteacher is willing to meet parents of all pupils moving into the area at any time by appointment.
